Nestled along the cobbled streets of the town of books, Hay on Wye, this gallery is run by a co-operative of designer makers. View and purchase fine silks, wire sculptures, paper art, wooden crafts and much more at this well-established and highly reputable gallery.



Old Chapel Gallery

In the centre of the chocolate box village, Pembridge find this former Victorian chapel with the very best in arts & crafts. Old Chapel has it all: fine art prints, woodwork, iron work, textiles and much more. Work includes emerging and established British artists and really is a treat to visit.



Trumpet Corner Galleries
