In 1861, the church of All Saints, Monkland was at the centre of a project that changed church life in the English-speaking world. The then vicar, Rev Sir Henry Williams Baker and his committee created Hymns Ancient and Modern which has become the leading hymnbook in the modern church. This remarkable book includes *Abide with me*, *Eternal Father, strong to save*, *The King of Love my shepherd is* and many more favourites that we all love singing.

The Sunday services are, as for any service, absolutely free apart from voluntary donations to Monkland Church.
